It wasn't easy at times, but we prevailed. Looking back, it seems as if I've attended hundreds of Design Review Board hearings (not quite that much but **lots!**), at times as many as three different projects going through the system simultaneously, Planning Commission and City Council hearings and appeals, Task Force Committees, Glendale Police Community Committees, Heritage Tree Preservation (all representing your interests to maintain the ambience of our Woodlands). I must say, the most proud I've been of our homeowners association was our success in convincing the City Council to establish a Military Recognition Banner program. We held a fundraiser in our back yard and raised \$5,000! The banners grace Glendale Boulevard and honor military with ties to Glendale who are serving in areas of conflict. Way to go Woodlands!

If I still have your attention, I strongly encourage you to consider volunteering your talent, provide input, suggestions etc., as a board member, committee member or newsletter coordinator on your homeowners association.
